Book Club Discussion Questions

1. Where (or from whom) did you learn about love?
2. How did the love you experienced while growing up compare against God's love as presented in this book?
3. How did your understanding of the ministry of the Holy Spirit change after reading this book?
4. In the Introductory chapter, Kimberly shared examples from her life where her initial expectations did not match the actual outcomes. Which areas of your life turned out differently than you expected?
5. After reading this book, what do you understand about God's will? How does your happiness fit into the equation? Prior to reading this book, did you believe it was God's will that you be happy? If so, what did you believe God would do to make you happy?
6. Knowing that God wants to communicate with you, do you hear God speak to you more often? If so, what situations create the best opportunity for you to hear from Him?
7. What new truth did you learn about the process of salvation?
8. If you were to rank the 4 occupation zones in order of influence over your life - which zone would receive top spot?
9. Can you identify some of the walls in your own life that prevent you from loving others unconditionally? What are you going to do about them?
10. Which areas of your life do you find it difficult to release control? Do you see a need to place the outcomes of situations into God's care?
11. In Chapter 8 Donna shared a story of how faulty thinking on her part taught her boys a misguided lesson on the value of money and education. Did this lesson bring an awareness to anywhere in your own life where your faulty thinking showed someone else a distorted picture of God's love?
12. Chapter 9 dealt with the ugliness of envy. Do you feel joy when you see the success of others?
13. Did this book bring an awareness of anyone in your life from whom you need to ask forgiveness? (Share only if appropriate) Did you receive awareness of anyone you need to forgive?
14. The Spiritual Disciplines keep the communication lines open in order for the Holy Spirit to remain filled within us. Which of the disciplines are a part of your life? What will you do differently?
15. Do you have a new awareness of what God's love is? If so, in your own words, define "love" as you now understand it.
16. Name a situation you've encountered, as you have read through this book, where you made the choice to react with God's agape rather than your default response. What were the specifics? How was your behavior different? What was the outcome?
17. In chapter 14, Donna and Kim shared the reasons that they press on toward the upward call to agape. Have you developed your own set of reasons? If you are comfortable share one of those reasons.
